Footnotes

CHULULA vied inside of rivals early, rated back off the leader around the far turn, angled out and came back three wide to challenge entering the stretch, responded to right handed pressure and forged to command a furlong out, dueled under solid hand urging the final sixteenth and held firm. POPALICIOUS vied three deep through the opening three sixteenths of a mile, spurted clear leaving the far turn, dropped in a bit to set a solid pace, was joined from her outside in upper stretch, drifted in a bit dueling past the three sixteenths marker and battled gamely to the wire. THISDANSEISTAKEN angled in nearing the turn to stalk the pace, edged up behind the top pair leaving the quarter pole, altered out when POPALICIOUS drifted in, regrouped and closed steadily. YES IT'S PERSIA, taken to rate while saving ground, moved up a bit in upper stretch, gave chase angling out past the eighth pole but came up empty. JESSIE CAN MAMBO settled back off the pace, saved ground into the lane then had belated interest. DIXIE SHEA chased the pace four wide and faded. IT'S SATURDAY NITE disputed the early pace between runners, rated back nearing the turn and angled out, chased to the head of the stretch then gave way.
