CLASSIC CONTENDER moved up three wide between horses leaving the turn, took command in midstretch and narrowly prevailed. MODEST GIRL, very wide in the stretch, closed. SOFT LINE DRIVE bore out leaving the starting gate, saved ground disputing the pace and weakened late. MEXICALI ROSE saved ground, angled out near the sixteenth pole and rallied mildly. ASAP, pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced five wide on the turn and failed to menace. SHE'SYERHUCKLEBERI saved ground, angled out in mid stretch and weakened between rivals. BETH'S HALO, in tight quarters leaving the starting gate, saved ground, swung wide in upper stretch and failed to menace. TRYSTER, four wide, gave way. BULLET ALDEN had speed in the two path and fell back. STARRY FLAG was outrun.
