Footnotes

FESTIVE LADY rated close up while off the rail, rallied four wide between rivals on the turn, took a short lead entering the lane then drew away under a drive. PLEASANT NOTE was unhurried early while wide, moved five wide with the winner mid way on the turn, was no match with that one from the head of the lane but finished willingly to be clear of the rest. POLISH VALENTINE bore out leaving the gate impeding ALECKS, moved up along the rail to take command nearing the five furlong marker, was collared by the winner approaching the quarter pole then weakened in the final sixteenth. RHYTHM DOWN BELOW lacked speed, circled five wide into the lane but failed to generate much of a response. ALECKS was jostled and pinched back at the break, chased the pace along the inside on the turn then faded. DIVINE ANGEL drifted in a bit leaving the gate, stalked the early pace between rivals then faltered approaching the lane. MISS BERAVEN , a forward factor three wide for a half mile, faltered. Following a stewards' inquiry and objection by the rider of ALECKS, POLISH VALENTINE was disqualified from third and placed fifth for interference leaving the starting gate.
