Footnotes

BILLY CHAPEL broke inward and brushed with PHIL'S TANGO, quickly corrected, advanced in hand leaving the far turn to take aim on the leader, bid three wide within himself after a half mile, took over under right handed pressure in upper stretch, kicked clear and was kept to solid hand urging the final sixteenth. ADAM'S NAY was taken back after an alert beginning, lagged well off the early pace, circled six wide into the stretch and closed steadily while on his left lead. YANO , nudged along off the rail giving chase, angled out around the turn, came four to five wide for the drive but lacked any serious response. PHIL'S TANGO , brushed at the break, saved ground while outrun early, angled out near mid stretch but failed to threaten. CLASS RULES sprinted well clear, set the pace towards the inside, was collared after a half mile, entered the lane three wide, gave willing chase of the winner to the eighth pole then surrendered.
