Footnotes

OVER MARKETED broke with the early leaders, was content to settle back off of a contested while saving ground, was roused right handed entering the lane, her rider lost the whip in upper stretch, skimmed the rail rallying inside rivals leaving the eighth pole, sputtered clear inside the sixteenth marker then held firm under steady hand encouragement. SIXTY ACRES saved ground stalking the pace, shifted out four wide inside the eighth pole and finished gamely. JOY TRAIN chased the dueling leaders while off the rail, altered out five wide in the drive and had a mild response. GO ALLIE dueled two to three wide outside FLATTERING ANNIE, held well to the sixteenth marker then weakened late. FLATTERING ANNIE dueled inside of GO ALLIE, came off the inside in upper stretch, held a tenuous advantage past the eighth pole then weakened. SECRET LIFE OF BEA lagged back, came five to six wide for the stretch run but failed to menace. MADALYN'S CHOICE failed to keep pace.
