L B'S EXPRESSION sprinted clear early, was nudged along off the rail while setting the pace, drifted out in upper stretch, was straightened away right handed inside the final furlong and held sway. FOXY SARA moved up four wide around the far turn, took closer order approaching the quarter pole, responded when set down inside the three sixteenths marker, finished gamely and gained quickly the final yards. STORMY ADVENTURE prompted the pace three to four wide, was floated out wider in upper stretch, altered leaving the eighth pole but lacked the needed finish. THIS IS HOW saved ground giving chase and faded. HOLIDAY ROAD GIRL failed to keep pace early, was well wide throughout and lacked a solid kick. EASTER FASHION , towards the inside early, eased out and was asked between foes mid turn but failed to deliver the needed punch. HELLO NOW broke a step slow, was hard used along the rail soon after, failed to keep pace and retreated.
