MISTY'S HOPE cleared early, set a rated pace inside, took pressure around the turn while still in hand, opened up when roused leaving the three sixteenths marker, held sway late then returned lame. RICHARD'S KID lacked speed, raced four wide around the turn, angled six wide for the drive and finished well to just get the place. NOT A GENTLEMAN, two wide around the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch, closed willingly but was edged for the place. GIRON saved ground, steadied when lacking room leaving the three sixteenths pole, got through along the rail near mid stretch and finished with interest. BLUE'S BABY BOY failed to menace. MR. PRIME TIME lacked speed, raced between rivals near the three eighths pole and failed to respond. SMOOTH IT OVER broke slowly and was outrun. QUIET SEARCH, well wide throughout, gave way. PETER'S CREEK stalked the winner while saving ground, angled out near the half mile marker, moved two wide to challenge early turn, vied to upper stretch and tired.
