**Footnotes**

RISKY RED stalked the pace, left the turn in the three path, bore in inside the three sixteenths pole, dueled with HAM AND ERNIE and narrowly prevailed under vigorous rousing. HAM AND ERNIE bobbed at the break, circled the turn, advanced four wide in upper stretch, dueled with the winner and hung. SAFE LANDING , in the four path between horses in upper stretch, rallied mildly. SAINTLY LOVE stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced in the two path between horses on the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and passed tired foes. GOLD CASING , wide on the turn, floated very wide entering the stretch and was no factor. MONEY FOR LOVE chased the pace well off the rail, angled to the two path leaving the turn then gave way. LIVE THE DASH , quickly clear, set the pace near the rail and faltered in upper stretch. OUR COMMANDER hugged the rail, briefly chased the pace and faltered leaving the turn.
