PLUM moved up four wide under rating nearing the five eighths pole and gained a tracking position, quickly moved to challenge mid way on the final turn, exchanged bumps with HARD MYSTERY leaving the quarter pole and again in upper stretch, dueled, was roused once left handed when assuming a short lead nearing the sixteenth pole then held firm from there under steady hand encouragement. HARD MYSTERY broke outward then was quickly corrected and sent up inside rivals to take command, set a slow and somewhat pressured pace, dueled inside the winner leaving the five sixteenths marker, came out into PLUM nearing the stretch, bumped again with that rival in upper stretch, continued on a tenuous lead past the furlong marker then stayed on gamely once headed. OFFICER'S HOLIDAY , sluggish from the gate, lost ground five to six wide into the backstretch, made a slight run nearing the three eighths pole, remained wide for the drive and lacked a solid finish. DO IT LUNA prompted the pace three wide, steadied when in close between the top pair leaving the five sixteenths marker then faded. WALLEYEDQUEEN , bumped at the break, saved ground stalking the pace then tired after six furlongs. LADY GREELEY , very rank under restraint when attempting to navigate between rivals the first turn, was wrangled back off of fillies near the five eighths pole, made a mild move leaving the far turn then lacked any further response. BREAK THE RECORD broke a step slow, was steadied off heels nearing the first turn, moved up between foes nearing the five furlong marker, stalked to the three eighths pole then tired.
