### Footnotes

SISTER RESISTOR , unhurried down the backstretch, circled the turn, entered the stretch four wide, gained a short lead near the quarter pole, dueled through the stretch and narrowly prevailed in a determined effort. MUSIC PLEASE , between horses down the backstretch, disputed the pace, left the turn in the two path, dueled with the winner through the lane and just missed in a game effort. CARRIETTA had speed along the rail, dropped back in upper stretch, swung wide in midstretch then passed tired foes. PINK PALLET lacked speed, advanced in the five path to reach a striking position in upper stretch, remained prominent to the eighth pole then gave way. AUTUMN GOLD disputed the pace three wide and gave way the final furlong.
