Footnotes

ORANGE'S LIL SIS dueled outside MY QUEEN on the turn, disposed of that one in upper stretch, dueled inside SLICK PHILLY the final furlong and proved best. SLICK PHILLY , four wide entering the stretch, drifted in when challenging for the lead approaching the eighth pole, dueled outside the winner and hung. PIONEER ZEPHYR , five wide leaving the turn, rallied. PLEASANT HYMN , in the five path turning for home, rallied mildly. GOOD LOOKING GIRL stalked the pace along the rail, eased out three wide leaving the turn, steadied behind horses in upper stretch then gave way. MY QUEEN saved ground, disputed the pace and gave way the final furlong. SURRENDERTHEMONEY saved ground on the turn and was not a factor.
