STORMATIC was sent up along the inside leaving the chute to join TOO SALTY FRO ME, dueled with that one into and around the turn while setting brisk fractions, edged clear in upper stretch and moved away under a drive. JOEL'S TOUCH had dead aim three wide off of the dueling leaders, loomed in mid stretch, finished willingly but was no match. ANDOVER BOY, well wide throughout, gained the show. INISH SHANK saved ground, was urged along around the turn and came up empty. TOO SALTY FOR ME sprinted to the early lead, dueled two wide and weakened leaving the three sixteenths marker. VALID BRUSH, between rivals, failed to respond. LOOKIN FOR BISCUIT, allowed to settle, made a mild four wide move mid turn then flattened out. ROCKABY BAY saved ground into the lane and failed to menace. HONORABLE MAN was not a factor.
