Footnotes

KIT KATS LUCK stalked the pace, was checked in tight quarters between horses near the three eighths pole, took the lead outside DE CHERA in upper stretch then drew clear while kept to her business. DE CHERA sped to the front, set the pace, saved ground around the far turn, weakened through the stretch and held the place. SHARIF AL MEDINA stalked the pace, raced inside horses in midstretch, angled out near the sixteenth pole and rallied mildly. REMITTANCE, well off the rail, passed tired horses. OCTORARO, unhurried to the stretch, swung very wide for the drive and passed tired foes. HAPPY DIGGER raced inside horses in the stretch and was not a factor. BIG ZEET chased the pace outside DE CHERA and faltered in upper stretch. WARLOCKED, three wide the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn and gave way. RUNAWAY BRUTE, inside horses entering the far turn, swung wide for the drive and was outrun. YANKEE PILOT, three wide both turns, chased the pace and faltered entering the stretch.
