Footnotes

SANDRO PAZZO prompted the early pace along the rail, was rated back off the top pair entering the turn, angled out and tracked past the three eighths marker, lodged a four wide bid between rivals nearing the lane, gained a slim lead in upper stretch, dueled inside WILLEM, was headed near the sixteenth marker, battled back under strong right handed pressure and regained command late. WILLEM, within range four wide into the turn, rallied five wide between horses entering the stretch, dueled outside the winner, gained a short lead past the sixteenth pole then hung. MO'S BRO saved ground under rating, eased out past the three sixteenths marker, split rivals a sixteenth out and finished with interest. HAWKNDOVE broke a step slow then was taken towards the inside, ranged up six wide nearing the stretch to challenge briefly, failed to sustain and weakened in the final furlong. FORECLOSURE was sent up between rivals and gained a short lead near the half mile marker, set a pressured pace towards the inside, battled to upper stretch then steadily gave way in the final furlong. LEGAL PAD, away alertly, pressed the pace three wide and weakened in the final eighth. ZIP ALONG, three wide nearing the half mile marker, was outrun.
