Footnotes

HIGH CRY lacked speed, circled horses on the turn, came into the stretch in the four path, bid for the lead near the eighth pole then drove clear. PALMETTO LANE saved ground, challenged for the lead in midstretch, finished gamely and was second best. QUEEN OF CHIC prompted the pace three wide, gained a clear lead leaving the turn and weakened late. OCTOMON , along the rail down the backstretch, bumped with PEACHES leaving the turn, continued to saved ground and rallied. MY SWEET NENANA , two wide on the turn, chased the pace, steadied lacking room entering the stretch, swung out and failed to rally. LISTENTOTHEWINDBLO , well off the rail, passed tired horses. OH SO NICE , steadied behind horses leaving the backstretch, raced along the rail in the stretch and was eased the final sixteenth of a mile. PERFECT MEASURE chased the pace, left the turn in the three path and gave way in upper stretch. LOOKY HERE was outrun. PEACHES bumped with OCTOMON leaving the backstretch, swung wide entering the stretch then gave way. KRUSIN KELLY dueled two wide early then faltered in upper stretch.
