Footnotes

LIGHTHOUSE BAY stalked the pace, circled the turn, entered the stretch in the four path, gained the lead in upper stretch, drifted out and bumped EK HASEENA near the sixteenth pole, brushed with that one near the wire and lasted. EK HASEENA lacked speed, left the turn in the five path, challenged for the lead outside LIGHTHOUSE BAY in midstretch, was bumped by that one near the sixteenth pole, brushed with that rival in deep stretch and just missed in a game effort. POWER LADY bobbed leaving the starting gate, hugged the rail, was checked in tight quarters inside BABY J in midstretch then finished gamely. FLATTERING BEA bobbed at the break, saved ground on the turn, swung wide in mid stretch and passed tired foes. BABY J set the pace just off the rail, came in on POWER LADY in mid stretch and gave way. JAX AND JILL chased the pace between horses and faltered in the drive. FOREST DIVA , wide turning for home, failed to rally. An objection by the rider of EK HASEENA against LIGHTHOUSE BAY for alleged interference in the stretch drive was not allowed.
