LOVE GETS EVEN dueled outside POLISH DISCO down the backstretch, gained command on the turn and steadily increased his advantage through the stretch while kept to his business. LUCKY STRIDE , between horses on the turn, chased the pace and held the place. TEA TOTT , urged down the backstretch, raced wide on the turn, chased the pace and weakened. ST MARY'S TROOPER , wide turning for home, passed tired foes. SKIDOODLE saved ground and lacked a serious rally. SNEAKY LOUIS lacked speed and passed tired rivals late. SPEEDY ARMORY raced along the rail and gave way. NO END , well off the rail, gave way. SIERRA CENA , wide entering the stretch, was not a factor. SHARP DREZZED MAN was outrun. POLISH DISCO dueled inside the winner and faltered.
