RED VOW hugged the rail, disputed the pace around the turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed in a determined drive. PEACE CAT prompted the pace three wide around the turn, bid for the lead in upper stretch, dueled with the winner and just missed in a game effort. ENDURING APPEAL saved ground on the turn, was steadied on the heels of a rival entering the stretch, hugged the rail in the lane and rallied mildly. TOMORROW'S TALE, wide entering the stretch, was set down in upper stretch and came up empty. BREEZY BOY, wide around the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then gave way. TOMORROWS WILDCAT broke slowly, rushed up early, disputed the pace two wide between horses and faltered in upper stretch.
