### Footnotes

SUMACHA'HOT lacked speed, swung to the eight path when commencing his rally in upper stretch, bore in sharply under right hand whipping when sprinting clear approaching the sixteenth pole, found himself along the rail inside the sixteenth pole and was kept to urging. BAGOGA , floated to the seven path between horses in upper stretch, rallied. SHAWKLIT POWER , wide turning for home, reached a striking position in midstretch then flattened out. MISTER DISH saved ground disputing the pace, opened up in midstretch then faded in the drive. THE SPANISH LIFE saved ground and lacked the needed rally. DE CHERA dueled outside MISTER DISH and gave way. CHANGING FUNDS , two wide leaving the far turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch and came up empty. SUE'S DIAMOND stalked the duel, moved up three wide leaving the far turn, drifted to the six path in upper stretch and faltered. THE RED HAMMER was outrun.
