CONCEALED IDENTITY saved ground under patient rating, eased out on the far turn, entered the stretch four wide, drifted out a bit in upper stretch, took command approaching the eighth pole, was under urging and drew off. MONUMENT HILL, unhurried inside horses, eased out entering the far turn, came into the stretch three wide, drifted out near the three sixteenths pole, drifted out near the eighth pole, drifted in near the sixteenth pole and weakened. DREAM LOUISE assumed the early lead, set the pace along the rail and weakened in midstretch. DAY FLIGHT stalked the pace, advanced in the two path between horses entering the stretch then gave way in midstretch. SIR RABBIT lacked speed, saved ground and failed to be a factor. LUCKY WILL, wide the far turn, dropped back.
