SCOTTISH HALO, unhurried early off the rail, steadily advanced four wide nearing the lane, gained command in mid stretch then drew clear under a right handed drive. UN FINO VINO prompted the pace two wide, moved to a short lead near the quarter pole then continued gamely although no match for the winner. GRUNDLEFOOT, void of speed, finished willingly outside to gain the show. TRAMS, off the rail, was put to urging leaving the three furlong marker, made a mild run to upper stretch then flattened out. UNRECORDED stalked the pace off the rail for six furlongs and tired. ALBERT SAYS sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, was headed approaching the quarter pole and tired. THREE WONDERS, off the rail into the backstretch, dropped back. SHADES CREEK, inside, stopped.
