### Footnotes

TAHOE KID prompted the pace two to three wide, lodged a bid mid turn, took over past the three sixteenths marker and kicked clear under strong handling. THE REAL PRINCE cleared early, set the pace inside, was collared in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. D' LIGHTFUL APPEAL lost ground three to four wide and lacked a solid response. FIESTA TEXAS failed to menace. DO YOUR DANCE stumbled at the break, recovered to stalk the pace while saving ground, raced forwardly to mid stretch then faded. WOODEN INDIAN broke slowly, raced wide and failed to menace. MACEY H , taken to rate early, made a mild run between rivals mid turn then tired leaving the three sixteenths marker. VETERAN GEORGIE , in tight at the break, trailed and was eased in the drive.
