Footnotes

OLIVER ZIP rated close up three and four wide, moved to challenge after three furlongs, took over without much urging nearing the quarter pole, opened up when roused in upper stretch, drifted in and widened under steady hand encouragement. BUCK N' HAM LANE moved up between rivals nearing the half mile marker, chased three to four wide for the final three eighths, finished up willingly through the last furlong and was clearly second best. LULU HAD A BABY, urged along four wide mid turn, had a mild response. POLLARD'S MAGIC stalked two to three wide, bid into turn, vied between runners past the five sixteenths marker, pursued to mid stretch then tired. BRAVEST, five wide, moved up nearing the turn, kept on with some progress to mid turn then flattened out. DETERMINING failed to keep pace. NICE WAY broke awkwardly, was urged along early and could not recover. OLDE BAY sprinted clear inside, set the early pace under rating, was joined after three furlongs, vied for nearly a half mile and tired.
