Footnotes

JOSTLE, four wide entering the backstretch, stalked the pace three wide, was put to pressure mid way on the final turn, put a head in front leaving the furlong marker then drew away under a drive. DAWN PRINCESS set the pace in the two path, weakened and just held the place. CLASS, between rivals stalking the pace, finished willingly. CASE OF THE BLUES, unhurried early, circled three wide into the lane and weakened. HIGH CODE, a bit difficult to rate around the first turn, prompted the pace along the rail for six furlongs then steadily retreated. HAWK AFFAIR was always outrun.
