THUNDEROUS G , under snug rating while saving ground, edged closer mid turn, angled out approaching the lane, took over within himself in upper stretch, spurted clear when roused past the the sixteenths marker then held firm under a drive. MYSTICAL TERP , hustled along between rivals leaving the far turn, continued a progression four wide into the stretch, gave game chase past the final furlong and was clearly second best. SUTTON ROAD saved ground, advanced nearing the lane, shifted out in upper stretch then needed more between foes. PEPPERMINT PRINCE broke awkwardly then was hard used between foes to go clear leaving the chute, moved out to a long lead approaching the turn, set the pace towards the inside, met the challenge of the winner into the lane, held willingly past the three sixteenths pole then gave way. EASTON JACK , hustled along four wide, had no significant kick. FLASHY BULLET failed to menace. SYMPHONIC HERO chased off the rail for nearly six furlongs then tired. FRANCESCO PUNCH stumbled at the break, saved ground and faded.
