LET'S PUNT settled three wide down the backstretch, lodged a bid into the far turn, took a short lead in upper stretch, went clear a furlong out then dug in gamely under pressure to narrowly prevail. TRUE SENSATION steadied around the first turn, moved up along the inside into the far turn, angled three wide for the drive, lodged a bid leaving the eighth pole, battled gamely and just missed. DIFFICULT set the pace along the inside and weakened through the final furlong. BOUTONNIERE raced wide, moved up some under urging leaving the far turn then faded through the lane. COMEON was in a bit tight leaving the gate and finished with some interest. TUFTON AVENUE stalked the pace two wide and dropped back leaving the far turn. BRUSH OFF broke slowly and was outrun. DANCING BALLADE dropped far back.
