Footnotes

ONE TO A ROYAL , rank leaving the starting gate, circled the turn three wide, took command inside the three sixteenths pole and drew out under pressure. SKIP THE TRIAL stalked the pace off the rail, eased out to the four path in upper stretch, advanced to midstretch then failed to sustain his bid. VOTE YES FOR LOVE , swung to the five path entering the stretch, remained on his left lead and rallied slightly. BIG M J chased the pace two wide, bid for the lead between horses in upper stretch then weakened. MASABI KING sped to a clear, early lead, set the pace along the rail and gave way in midstretch. VALUED TRUST , outrun, circled the turn. GRAND SLAM FRANKIE , inside horses on the turn, dropped back. HAIL TO THE CHIEF saved ground and stopped in upper stretch.
