DAYS LIKE THIS was sent up between rivals soon after the break, advanced three wide under a light hold and took over nearing the half mile marker, moved away approaching the quarter while remaining well removed from the inside, responded when shaken up in upper stretch, turned away a mild inside threat in mid stretch and widened the advantage under right handed pressure. SEEYOUINTHETOWN was rated back a bit after an alert break, stalked the pace leaving the far turn, made her way between rivals mid turn, angled in for the drive, made a run at the winner with a furlong to go, continued gamely but simply was no match. GANZA vied inside rival through the opening furlong, dropped back off the issue nearing the half mile marker, angled out and advanced three wide into the lane, worked between rivals in mid stretch and finished with interest. HEAVENLY CHOIR failed to keep pace early, was navigated out four wide for the drive, made slight progress near the furlong pole then flattened out. DINER GAL was steadied when in close between rivals near the five and a half furlong marker, lost ground while well wide throughout and failed to recover. VALIANT STAR forced the early issue between rivals, dropped to the rail and chased the winner around the turn then retreated through the final quarter mile. SOUTHERN PLAYMATE was sent up four wide nearing the half mile marker and briefly posed a threat, chased past the three eighths pole and was all done before going a half mile.
