PROSPERO was steadied soon after the break, settled five wide, commenced a run leaving the three eighths pole, shifted out wider continuing a run in upper stretch, ranged up to take command inside the sixteenth marker, responded to strong handling and held firm. MAGIC EIGHT BALL, forwardly placed along the rail, shuffled back and bobbed leaving the four and half furlong marker, regrouped to save ground around the turn, edged up then awaited room near the quarter pole, worked outward to about the six path in the final furlong, lodged a bid between rivals and kept on gamely inside the winner while earning the place. MEWANNAROSE, taken to rate four wide while not far back, advanced in hand nearing the stretch, rallied to command just past the eighth pole, was joined from the outside by the top pair a sixteenth out, dueled and stayed on well. DR. DREW came in some after the break, straightened and sprinted clear, set the pace two to three wide, was taken on in mid stretch, gave brief resistance then faded. KEEP MOMMA HAPPY chased the pace, moved closer between rivals mid turn, kept in range to the eighth pole, shifted in and came up empty. QUINBY PETE stalked the pace three wide, was under pressure between rivals in upper stretch, failed to kick on and gradually retreated. TIME HAS COME, between runners into the turn, failed to respond. PEEDS IN A POD saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in upper stretch.
