Footnotes

MEGHAN'S JOY saved ground, swung wide near the sixteenth pole, closed and was up in time. EESSEE'S LASS stalked the pace and rallied between horses. AMOURETTE raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace two wide into the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and weakened late. LADY CRUELLA was rated between horses to midstretch, swung wide and rallied mildly. LT'L MANDY A set the pace along the rail and weakened. NORTHERN FLAIR dwelt at the break, raced wide around the far turn and passed tired ones. SKIBO was no factor and raced very wide into the stretch. NIGHTIME DANCES was steadied in traffic entering the first turn, circled the far turn and weakened in the stretch. SUDENLYLASTSUMMER raced between horses and weakened. GINGER'S PROUD was outrun and raced wide around the far turn. AUNTIE ADELE had speed along the rail and stopped. .
