Footnotes

KEY TO A CURE had speed along the rail, was eased back approaching the turn, angled to the two path entering the stretch, closed between horses and was up in time. BEACON HALL saved ground, disputed the pace and missed in a sharp effort. FATHER MUDD dueled two wide between horses on the turn, drifted out near the eighth pole and weakened in the drive. I. TURNER stalked the pace, raced very wide on the turn, gained a brief lead in midstretch then gave way. BROWN FEATHER , swung very wide in upper stretch, was no threat. ALL FOR PEACE , steadied near the five eighths pole, raced well off the rail and was not a factor. E. Z. PATH , wide around the turn, dueled to upper stretch and faltered in midstretch. ADIOS AMIGO saved ground and faltered.
