Footnotes

CASTLETON PARK was sent up between rivals early to track the pace, moved to engage the leader around the far turn, pressed then took over three wide into the stretch, responded to strong handling to go well clear a furlong out then held firm under pressure. THIRD N THIRTEENTH was rated back from off the lead leaving the chute, settled four wide while in range, was roused near the three furlong marker, continued four wide into the stretch and closed steadily. MAHARANI URSULA was nudged along while failing to keep pace early, angled out early turn, came four wide for the drive and finished up well between rivals. SILVER MON was sent up along the rail and took command past the five eighths pole, was joined by the winner nearing the turn, took pressure to the head of the lane then weakened in the final furlong. ROYAL CROSS lagged back, circled the turn five wide, had some belated action but never factored. OUR PRINCE CHARLIE disputed the early pace five wide, angled in and chased the leaders around the turn, remained a forward presence to upper stretch and gave way. GUNG HO BILL was sent up between foes early to reach contention, stalked the leaders while saving ground leaving the far turn, came under pressure mid turn and dropped back. CLICKIT OR TRICKIT was outrun. STAY I INSIST vied four wide between rivals past the five eighths pole then stopped leaving the three eighths pole.
