BRYAN'S JEWEL broke a step slow, settled back off of a contested pace, advanced in hand leaving the three eighths pole, angled out and made a bold six wide run to blow past the leaders in upper stretch, lugged in while clear a furlong out, responded to right handed pressure and turned away an inside bid from AFTER THE APPLAUSE. AFTER THE APPLAUSE was angled to the rail leaving the half mile marker, rated off the leaders, gained under patient handling in upper stretch, lodged a bid inside the winner a sixteenth out, continued willingly but was denied. BANDOLA dueled in the three path outside SHE'SMYLITTLEMAN, poked a head in front with three furlongs remaining, disputed the issue four deep between rivals in upper stretch then gave way grudgingly. GROOVITUDE , away alertly, tracked the leaders four to five wide, challenged between rivals in upper stretch but failed to sustain. SHE'SMYLITTLEMAN was sent up inside rivals to gain a short lead, was overtaken after three furlongs, continued to battle while in three path into the lane, gave way grudgingly and steadied near the sixteenth pole. STERLING VOW saved ground off the pace, eased out near the quarter pole and failed to respond.
