EVEN KEEL , patiently rated early while off the rail, advanced four wide into the lane while under a light hold, responded when roused in upper stretch, rallied to command in mid stretch, kicked clear under pressure and lugged in late. SUPER CUB settled inside into the turn, angled out four to five wide for the drive, closed willingly and gained the place. NANICOKE , between rivals early contesting the pace, prompted two wide early turn, took command leaving the three eighths pole, briefly went clear in upper stretch then faded in the final sixteenth. LADY ANN SUMMERS , taken to rate, moved closer between rivals mid turn, continued between rivals into the stretch then came up empty. BLONDIE'S HALOS stalked the pace off the rail, lost ground four wide while advancing around the turn, continued a presence into the stretch then faded. SHE'S OUR HERO saved ground, moved closer in upper stretch, swung out five wide then lacked a bid through the final furlong. KEY LIME TIME was used hard from the gate, disputed pace along the rail, went clear into the turn, battled to upper stretch then tired in the final eighth. SMART 'N STORMY disputed the early pace three wide and gave way mid turn.
