BATTINGSTAR disputed the pace outside CAGEY ACT, came three wide into the lane with a short lead, drifted out some in upper stretch, was straightened away soon after, edged clear past the furlong marker and proved best under a drive. DICED N SLICED stalked the pace while saving ground, eased out in upper stretch, advanced between rivals past the furlong marker and continued on willingly to be clear for the place. SARAH CATALDO stalked the pace three to four wide, moved menacingly nearing the stretch, switched to her left lead near mid stretch then lacked the needed finish. CAGEY ACT duelled inside the winner and gave way grudgingly. PORLAMAR, taken to rate off the rail, made a mild four wide run approaching the five sixteenths marker then flattened out. WHAT SHE SAID broke sluggishly and raced removed from the rail in a dull effort. GIVONNA ALYSSA, bumped and shuffled back early, failed to recover. EXONERATED, bumped soon after the break, chased the pace while between rivals and tired in upper stretch.
