Footnotes

POLISH DANCE broke alertly then rated comfortably outside JILL THE PILL, moved three wide in hand to collar that rival after a half mile, assumed command nearing the five sixteenths marker, edged clear into the stretch, responded when set down and widened under a right handed drive. IRIS' PROVERB, taken to rate off the rail, was nudged on three wide between rivals after a half mile, continued between foes while in the four path in upper stretch, finished willingly and earned the place. ROBYNS ANTHEM prompted the pace while saving ground, edged closer into the turn, lodged a rail bid three furlongs out, vied inside the winner to the head of the lane then steadily faded the final sixteenth. LATIN COAST lacked speed while saving ground, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a solid run. MERRY BERRY lost ground four to five wide, made a mild advance mid turn, continued five wide into the stretch, angled in late but failed to seriously threaten. SHOE BABE saved ground and faded. JILL THE PILL bobbled at the break, recovered and was sent up between rivals to go clear leaving the chute, set the pace removed from the rail, was overtaken past the half mile marker, drifted out in upper stretch and tired. HELLO EASY STREET lacked speed, raced wide in the drive and was not a threat.
