**Footnotes**

MAY ONE , unhurried, advanced two wide on the far turn, eased out four wide at the head of the stretch, closed and drew off under brisk urging. BLONDIE'S HALOS , four wide entering the first turn, sprinted clear entering the far turn, saved ground around the final bend and tired in the drive. STAR MOM broke slowly, was wide around the far turn, drifted out in midstretch and passed tired rivals. SILVER HUNTER saved ground and weakened through the stretch. TOP OF THE TREE , steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, circled the far turn and gave way. COAL VALLEY hugged the rail and was outrun. RHEMA , three wide entering the first turn, showed speed to the far turn then faltered. CRUISE OVER CLOVER , six wide entering the first turn, dropped back down the backstretch. TOGA TIGER , five wide entering the first turn, remained well off the rail and faltered.
