SOUTHERN RAINBOW took some early pressure while setting a rated pace three wide, moved clear into the turn, widened nearing mid stretch, was roused briefly approaching the sixteenth marker then was geared down late. READY SET, unhurried early, saved ground around the turn, made a rail run in upper stretch, continued willingly and was clear for the place. TORPEDO RUN bobbled at the break, lost ground four wide and kept trying to the finish. IN THE JUICE stalked the pace three wide and gave way grudgingly. KAUFY BIG SHOT, urged along between rivals nearing the three eighths pole, faded. LUCKIFEE failed to menace. APPLE SPECIAL stalked the pace off the rail and gave way in upper stretch. DIAMOND DAVID forced the early pace inside and faltered.
