NASHI prompted the pace two wide early, moved between rivals to duel around the turn, gained a short lead into the lane while drifting out a bit, edged clear under right handed pressure nearing the furlong marker then was fully extended to stave off ACTIN LUCKY. ACTIN LUCKY was nudged to the front while inside, took heavy pressure leaving the three eighths pole, dueled past the five sixteenths marker, dropped back a bit off the winner nearing mid stretch then battled back gamely through the final seventy yards. FLATTERING ANNIE, taken to rate off the rail and off the contested pace, moved boldly four wide mid turn, forced the issue while floated out a bit in upper stretch then could not match strides in the final furlong. ORIENTAL CRUISE, forwardly placed along the rail, was pushed along mid turn but failed to respond. ALBRIGHT, away alertly, prompted the pace three wide, moved to threaten into the turn, dueled between rivals past the five sixteenths pole, steadied when in a bit close entering the stretch then gave way. DESAFINADO BAY failed to keep pace.
