### Footnotes

BELARUS lacked speed, raced well off the rail, swung to the extreme outside in midstretch, closed strongly and readily pulled away. ROCKIN CLOCKIN stalked the pace, eased out to the three path leaving the turn, gained a short lead in midstretch, was no match for the winner but was best of the others. SCARLET'S NUMBER, swung extremely wide near the quarter pole, rallied mildly. YSABELL T. saved ground on the turn, eased out in upper stretch and failed to sustain her bid. DANCIN DIANE stalked the pace, was four wide entering the stretch and gave way near the three sixteenths pole. DIXIE DUMPLING lacked speed, raced wide on the turn, angled very wide in upper stretch and was not a factor. CHASING DAYLIGHT prompted the pace two wide and faltered the final furlong. LADY MUDBUG lacked speed and was outrun. ADA BELLE was outrun. RHAPSODY IN ROAN set the pace along the rail and stopped near the three sixteenths pole.
