

## **Footnotes**

OIL RIG attended the pace three wide under confident handling, dueled while still in hand past the five sixteenths marker, took over entering the stretch, responded when set down, drew clear past the three sixteenths marker, drifted out and held firm under a drive. PRETENSION quickly to contention under a rating hold, prompted the pace inside, dueled past the five sixteenths marker, drifted off the inside in upper stretch but stayed on well to be clear for the place. TRIPPI'S SECRET settled back off the pace while three wide, angled out six to seven wide for the drive and closed belatedly to get the show. JUST SAYIN, in range three to four wide, failed to generate a solid run. KALAS saved ground, was pushed along past the three eighths pole but failed to respond. BULL H, away alertly, set a pressured pace between rivals and faded in mid stretch. FRESHY FRANCESCO, fractious in the gate, broke awkwardly, rushed up between rivals to be just off the leaders after a quarter mile, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole, failed to response and weakened.
