POLISH MOE quickly went clear, set the pace inside while well in hand, was pushed along some in upper stretch and maintained a safe margin under steady hand pressure. TOURAINE settled off the inside, circled into the lane and finished willingly for the place. KENTUCKY TIMBER saved ground, angled out midway on the final turn, angled back in approaching the lane and finished with interest. HUNT THE FOX stalked the pace two wide, was put to pressure around the final turn and weakened. DEVIL'S ISLAND lacked speed, raced between rivals around the far turn and failed to respond. BOYS WILL BE BOYS was bumped leaving the gate, chased the pace along the inside and tired. CRAZY CARPENTER lacked speed, raced very wide and tired.
