Footnotes

CATCH A THIEF advanced inside rivals nearing the three quarter pole to put a head in front, was well rated taking pressure while in the two path around the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch, responded when roused left handed to regain her advantage leaving the three sixteenths marker then steadily pulled away in the final furlong. BALTIMORE BELLE prompted the pace three wide between rivals, moved to short lead leaving the quarter pole, dueled briefly, continued on willingly but could not match strides through the final eighth. BRAVE AS A LION led early while four wide, prompted the issue while continuing four wide around the turn, failed to respond when roused and faded in the lane. SQUABBLE, under snug rating early while not far back, angled to the rail early turn, moved a bit closer leaving the three eighths pole but had no stretch response. MALIBU MOON DANCE chased the leaders while off the rail, was put to a solid ride four wide past the three eighths pole and gave way. MISS SPEAK vied briefly between rivals, dropped back into the turn, swung out wide for the drive and came up empty.
