RUNNIN UTE pressed the pace outside POLISH MARY, took command entering the far turn, drifted out inside the sixteenth pole and prevailed under vigorous rousing. BOAST , three wide the first turn, raced in the two path on the far turn and rallied inside the winner. ILLUCINATION stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced three wide the first turn, swung four wide in upper stretch and was no factor. TOWNLINE raced along the rail in the stretch and rallied. QUIET CELERITY , wide the far turn, gave way. POLISH MARY had speed along the rail and faltered. ONE SWEET DAY was outrun. STONE FLEET , four wide the first turn, raced three wide the far turn and stopped.
