FREE DUBAI , unhurried early, raced wide around the far turn, closed under brisk urging and drew out. READY TO PLAY raced wide around the far turn, gained a clear lead in midstretch and weakened late. BRED TO WIN , taken back entering the backstretch, was angled to the five path near the half mile pole, remained very wide and rallied too late. SURVEYOR , steadied in close quarters entering the first turn, raced between rivals and failed to rally. GENERALISSIMO bobbled leaving the starting gate, raced wide around the first turn, dueled and gave way. RANDOM STRIKE prompted the pace three wide between horses and gave way. MY SON M J showed speed along the rail and gave way. GINAS WONDER was no factor. MISTER RUNSTADLER dueled two wide and faltered.
