Footnotes

BAYOU BENGAL stalked a contested pace three wide, was put to strong hand urging mid turn, kept on willingly under left handed pressure, moved to even terms just past the sixteenth marker then edged clear. ELLIPSE set a pressured pace inside, was put to a drive leaving the three sixteenths marker, held a tenuous lead nearing the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. HIGH BAR prompted the pace two wide, applied more pressure mid turn, vied between horses nearing the sixteenth pole and stayed on well. COACH FRIDGE saved ground off the pace, came under a strong ride leaving the far turn, shifted out and closed the gap. CORUNDUM chased the pace four wide, drifted five wide near the quarter pole and came up empty. R. BEE ESS, taken to rate three wide, made a mild run between rivals near the quarter pole, altered out a bit wider and weakened. PETEY CRAMER chased towards the inside and weakened. KENDALLS BEAR hesitated at the break and was outrun. STRONG SHAFT put in a dull try.
