Footnotes

BOMBAY BEACHES , confidently rated slightly off the rail, was set down in midstretch and pulled away. BEAUTIFUL SWIMMER , steadied in close quarters along the rail leaving the backstretch, eased out to the two path on the turn, chased the winner and weakened. HOLY SUGAH circled the turn, was three deep entering the stretch and failed to sustain her bid. SUMMER TIME RANGER saved ground and passed tired horses. MIDIAN , wide on the turn, swerved in near the three sixteenths pole and was not a factor. HOTSPUR HARRIET , swung to the five path in upper stretch, failed to rally. ROARING JUNEBUG , wide on the turn, was outrun. DERWIN'S GOLD was not a factor. JOSIE'S DEVIL stalked the pace, was three deep midway on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. YES I CAN showed brief speed along the rail then faltered.
