TAPIT broke a bit in the air, quickly accelerated to contention along the inside, checked on heels when a bit rank entering the backstretch, awaited room inside under rating to the three furlong marker, angled out mid way on the final turn, found room between rivals leaving the three sixteenths marker, surged to command a furlong out, drew off impressively and won handily. POLISH RIFLE broke a step slow, angled out three to four wide around the first turn, advanced wide under rating into the far turn, loomed a major presence nearing the lane, continued willingly to gain the place but was no match for the winner. GHOST MOUNTAIN broke on top, stalked the pace three wide under rating, moved to command leaving the three furlong pole, edged clear into the lane, was overtaken by the winner in mid stretch then weakened a bit in the final sixteenth. ACCLIMATE set a pressured pace along the inside, was overtaken around the final turn, forced the issue into the lane, angled out leaving the eighth pole and kept trying to the finish. CAPEJINSKY had a wide trip and failed to respond. CHARISMATIC CALLER saved ground, was put to urging into the far turn, swung out in the drive but lacked a rally. TYM BEAU prompted the pace two wide and tired leaving the three furlong marker.
