Footnotes

NIGHT OFFICER rated three wide behind a contested pace, swung out five wide entering the stretch, rallied on his left lead, took command a furlong, lugged in some and drew clear under a drive. REGAL STRIKE prompted the pace three wide under rating, dueled two wide between rivals mid turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch, was overtaken a furlong out then stayed on well to hold the place. ROCK SOLID ARCH moved up inside rivals to take a short lead after a quarter mile, took pressure while under some urging, dueled mid turn to upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. SOLDIER FIELD saved ground, edged closer mid turn, angled out from behind rivals in upper stretch, worked further out inside the eighth pole but could only gain mildly. FOREST KING , close up while under rating four wide, moved three wide to threaten after three furlongs, dueled to mid stretch then faded. ZAGARELLO saved ground early, rated back into the turn, angled out, circled four wide into the stretch but failed to respond. GIANT PATRIOT rushed up between rivals early, dueled past the five eighths pole, continued to force the pace into the turn then faltered after a half mile.
