Footnotes

JANE'S KID settled back off of a contested early pace, advanced four wide into the stretch, rallied four wide under strong handling in mid stretch, took command soon after and drew clear. BEAN lagged early, came five wide for the drive and rallied while on his left lead. DEELITEFULPROSPECT tracked the pace in hand, rallied three wide to a clear lead mid turn, widened into the stretch but could not last the final eighth. AMERICA'S DARLIN chased the pace off the rail and continued on willingly. HANDSOME BRUNO prompted the pace two wide, move to near even terms into turn, battled past the three and a half furlong marker then weakened in upper stretch. ECRU EGRET failed to menace and raced wide in the lane. LEAGLENOTE had no mishap and gave way. GAMMY'S A WINNER was rushed from the gate, set a pressured pace inside, dueled leaving the far turn then faltered in upper stretch.
